Between the 25 and 27 March 2019, INTERPOL's Global Pollution Enforcement Team will be hosting a post-operational meeting for the recently completed Operation 30 Days at Sea, with representatives from participating countries in attendance.

Operation 30 Days at Sea, targeting marine pollution crime, was carried out over 30 days in October this year, involving 276 law enforcement and environmental agencies across 58 countries. This resulted in the detection of more than 500 offences, including illegal discharges of oil and garbage from vessels, shipbreaking, breaches of ship emissions regulations, and pollution on rivers and land-based runoff to the sea.

A vital aspect of this operation was the introduction and use of new technologies and methods to combat this emerging crime threat. During the tactical phase of the operation, Officer Jerry Akubo was a leader in terms of the implementation of the Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), or drone, to support Nigerian operational efforts.

During the post operational meeting, we will have a session specifically showcasing and discussing Innovative Technologies used during the operation, and we would like to focus on drone use for this crime type. To do this we request to have Officer Jerry Akubo (UAV Drone Expert) in attendance at the conference in March 2019. We would envisage that Officer Akubo can present on the technical aspects of drone use, advantages, evidence gathering techniques, as well as surveillance capabilities.

On behalf of the INTERPOL Global Pollution Enforcement Team (GPET) I would like to take this opportunity to pass on our appreciation for the assistance provided by your Officer, INTERPOL National Technical Officer, Jerry AKUBO, during Operation 30 Days at Sea.

Operation 30 Days at Sea, targeting marine pollution crime, was carried out over 30 days in October this year, involving 276 law enforcement and environmental agencies across 58 countries. This resulted in the detection of more than 500 offences, including illegal discharges of oil and garbage from vessels, shipbreaking, breaches of ship emissions regulations, and pollution on rivers and land-based runoff to the sea.

A vital aspect of this operation was the introduction and use of new technologies and methods to combat this emerging crime threat. During the tactical phase of the operation, Officer Jerry Akubo was a leader in terms of the implementation of the Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), or drone, to support Nigerian operational efforts. An INTERPOL GPET Officer was present at Apapa Port and observed Officer Akubo provide a detailed briefing to all participating agencies on the specifications and capabilities of the drone to support their operational activities. This included the ability to detect pollution events from the air, as well as to conduct photogrammetry and orthomosaic, in and around the area of Apapa Port. This was followed by a demonstration of the drone during operational work.

The use of UAV is an innovative and modern technology which assists agencies to safely carry out operational activities, and assists in the identification of pollution incidents. This allows for the timely allocation of resources and investigative teams to the pollution location. The capabilities of this technology also allows for accurate mapping of pollution incidents, which will assist agencies in the presentation of quality evidence in court in the event of a prosecution. INTERPOL will continue to develop and explore the use of this technology to target and investigate marine pollution crime, as well as other crime types.

In closing, thank you again for your support and the provision of an excellent officer who contributed greatly to the success of the operation. Officer Akubo's expertise and professionalism was evident and it is hoped that his expertise in this area can be developed to enable INTERPOL to use his skills during future operations.
